REFLECTION

Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The reading today from Gospel Summary Matthew's Gospel takes place early in Jesus' ministry. Several ideas are clear. First of all, Matthew strived to connect his Gospel for the early Christians to their Jewish heritage. He made several references in his Gospel like the one today in which prophecies of old are fulfilled in Jesus. The second thing was that Jesus learned of John the Baptist's arrest and resolved to begin his ministry away from Herod. Finally, Jesus called with some urgency, his first four disciples. Renewing our appreciation of INDULGENCE

This can be an opportunity for the faithful to turn over a new leaf, wipe the slate clean and get back on the road to salvation. Note: in addition to normal confession times (Sat. at 4:15-4:45PM), Father will hear confessions on Sunday Feb. 3 at 7:00 PM in the Church.
