### Lent Through the Eyes of Luke

Luke—the evangelist with a baton... Every year, we suddenly realize that the season of Lent is here and every year, we sincerely promise: "This year I'm going to do better." In the past, our usual efforts at prayer, fasting and good works in preparation for Easter sometimes seem to lose focus. We need a conductor to keep us focused on the overall effort. Many of the Lenten readings this year (Year C), feature a great conductor in the person of St. Luke the Evangelist. Just as an orchestra conductor provides a sensitive interpretation of the composer's mind and vision, so also this Gospel writer provides his own personal style in telling the story of redemption.

Perhaps a fresh approach to Lent might focus on one story which is unique to the Gospel of Luke. Under the baton of Luke, we hear the classic parable of the prodigal son (15:1-3; 11-32).
