The parable of the Good Samaritan:

Who is my neighbor whom I must love like myself?...this was a trick question. Jesus responds with one of the most beautiful of all the parables, the Good Samaritan. Jesus has demolished all boundary expectations. It is not social definitions such as class, religion, gender, or ethnicity that determines who is our neighbor. **A neighbor is a person who acts with compassion toward another.** The point becomes not who deserves to be loved as I love myself, but that I become a person who treats everyone with compassion. **The key is to do it.**
