**The baptism of our Lord** is considered a manifestation of God in Jesus, another 'epiphany' that we celebrate on this, the last day of the Christmas season.



**ORDINARY TIME:** The liturgical color for Ordinary Time is **green**. Green is meant to symbolize hope, to be a symbol of life and begins following the Baptism of the Lord. This 'time' is anything but ordinary, but represents the ordered life of the Church—the period in which we live our lives neither in feasting (as in the Christmas and Easter seasons) or in more severe penance (as in Advent and Lent), **but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second Coming of Christ.**
