Easter Message God has turned our sorrow into joy by raising Jesus from the dead. When the angels asked the women at the tomb, "Why are you weeping?" (John 20:13), they were announcing a truth that would change the world forever. The resurrection of Jesus has become the wellspring of our faith, transforming our hopelessness into hopefulness.
